THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM JOANNA WYN JACKSON

April 21, 2024

PRESENTATION

Minister:

Hear the words of our Lord Jesus Christ: All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

Obeying the word of our Lord Jesus, and confident of his promises, we baptize those whom God has called. In baptism God claims us, and seals us to show that we belong to God. God frees us from sin and death, uniting us with Jesus Christ in his death and resurrection. By water and the Holy Spirit, we are made members of the church, the body of Christ, and joined to Christ's ministry of love, peace, and justice.

Let us remember with joy our own baptism as we celebrate this sacrament this day.

Elder: On behalf of the session, I present Joanna Wyn Jackson, daughter of Meredith Davis and Matt Jackson, to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

Minister: Meredith and Matt, having heard God's gracious promises to us in Christ, do you desire that Joanna be baptized? **We do.**

Relying on God's grace, do you promise to live the Christian faith, and to teach that faith to Joanna? **We do.**

QUESTIONS TO THE CHILDREN

Do you promise to be a friend to Joanna? Yes!

If she needs direction, will you show her the way? Yes!

Will you play with her, sing with her, and learn the stories of Jesus with her? **Yes!**

QUESTION TO THE CONGREGATION

Elder: Do we, as members of the Church of Jesus Christ, promise to guide and nurture Joanna, by word and deed, with love and prayer, encouraging her to know and follow Christ and to be a faithful member of his church? **We do.**

*THE APOSTLES' CREED

Minister: I invite you now to rise in body or in spirit as we confess our faith with the whole church, using the words of the Apostles' Creed, on p. 35 in our hymnal.

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth,

And in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; he descended into hell; the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Ghost; the holy catholic Church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.

Elder: Pour water from pitcher into bowl, just before prayer starts. Pour visibly and audibly.

PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING OVER THE WATER

Lord God, in a dry, thirsty, broken world, water has ever been a sign of your faithfulness. Through the waters of the Red Sea, you brought your people out of bondage. Across the River Jordan, you brought them into the promised land. Our Lord Jesus Christ was baptized in those same waters, sharing with us in your covenant faithfulness. Therefore, saving God, we bless you for the water with which you bless us. As she passes through these baptismal waters, we pray that Joanna will live in your grace as she shares in Christ's risen life.

Send your Holy Spirit upon us and upon this water, that all who are gathered under this sign may be one in Christ. We ask your blessing upon Joanna, and upon Meredith and Matt, and that their life together may be a sharing in the abundant joy of your kingdom. May their home be a place of light and life and love for you and for one another. To you be all praise, honor, and glory; through Jesus Christ our Savior, who, with you and the Holy Spirit, lives and reigns forever. Amen.

Elder: Pick up and hold bowl.
